Dear Churches, Pastors, and Friends:



We praise God that we were able to finish our LAST FULL MONTH OF DEPUTATION!!! We praise the Lord for keeping us safe over the last 3 ½ years of deputation and ministry. **We are at 93% of our needed support** and God has strongly put on my heart that **it is time for us to be FINISHED on the deputation trail.** **Please pray with us that God will give us 5 to 10 more supporting churches** from the churches we have visited. We have been in about **25 states, driven 127,305 miles,** and been in **over 200 churches.** Thank you to every church and pastor that allowed us to come! We do praise the Lord that Grapevine Baptist Church in North Carolina and Crossroads Baptist Church in Virginia **took us on for support this past month!**

We began March with a wonderful Missions conference at Colonial Baptist Church in Rogers, AR. From there we traveled to Georgia, but had major brake problems on our van, which delayed us a few days. After the meeting in Georgia, we returned for a special Missions Sunday at Bible Baptist Church in Conway, AR. From there we headed to Tennessee where we filled in for Pastor Caleb Bowling. While there, after I preached at a men’s rehab, **three men professed Christ!** In April, my wife got to talk with a lady at an altar call and **she professed Christ!** We were refreshed to see people come to Christ and reminded of why we serve God’s servants. We spent the rest of April in North Carolina and Virginia visiting many wonderful churches.

As I write this letter I am reminded of James 4:15, *For that ye ought to say, **If the Lord will, we shall live, and do this, or that.*** We had to cancel our Iowa trip due to our whole family getting RSV, but we see the Lord’s hand in stopping us so we can rest and reorganize. Lord willing, our next stop is Mountain Home, AR, where Church Planter Jonathan Ellis is having an eight-day tent revival **to start Mountain Home Bible Baptist Church.** Please contact me if you would like to help with this! May 11-15 is John/Romans distribution and May 16-24 is the tent revival. We are excited to get to take part in this!

RV Situation: We used our RV for the first time! Thank you to Pastor Nathan Davidson, Cedar Crest Independent Baptist Church, and Victory Baptist Church for your work and gifts toward this. **We still need about \$20,000-25,000 to cover the repairs and have a dependable way to tow a vehicle. OUR GOAL is to use this RV as a home for our family while we help church planters and pastors around the US.**
