Report Letter

Dear Churches, Pastors, and Friends:



We began September in New Mexico with the McDaniels family at Naschitti Baptist Church. We tore down and rebuilt their wheelchair ramp and completed several other projects for them as well. We also were able to replace two faucets and a drain in the McDaniels personal home and put in two bedroom doors for them. Then we went down to Albuquerque and helped Solid Rock Baptist Church, a church plant, by tearing out an old baptistry and enlarging their platform. We then were able to fill in for church planter Ryan Nez at Old Paths Baptist Church in Window Rock, AZ. I am thankful for the many pastors and church planters out in New Mexico and Arizona. God is doing great things on the Navajo Reservation and the surrounding areas. The rest of September and October was spent traveling **around 8000 miles** to Missions Conferences, special meetings, and presenting Serving God's Servants as much as possible. There have been many ups and downs along the way, but we are thankful for God's goodness in giving us traveling mercies!

So far, two churches, Union Baptist Church in Florien, LA and Crimson Avenue Baptist Church in Nixa, MO have taken us on from this trip! We are excited as we visit a few more churches in November. We are very close to 90% support now. **Would you please pray with us that God would give us the last 10% by the start of next year?** I believe if we had ten more churches take us on for support, we will have our personal support raised. We are amazed at God's goodness to us and could never imagine all that God would allow us to do on this three year journey of raising support, doing projects, and assisting that we've been on.

Prayers Answered!!! We were able to purchase a Chevrolet Express Passenger Van and have already put 6,000 miles on it since we got it. God also allowed us to sell our Transit Van and an older 15 passenger van we had as well! We are praising the Lord for His provision in this area. **Prayer Request** - We are still heavily praying for a large RV (a Diesel Class A or Super C) that would allow us to travel more easily as a large family and allow us to stay in an areas for weeks or months at a time to help church planters or pastors who are struggling. We know this is a big request, and we are not going to rush into trying to purchase one, but we truly believe this would allow us to travel more smoothly and help our family unit.

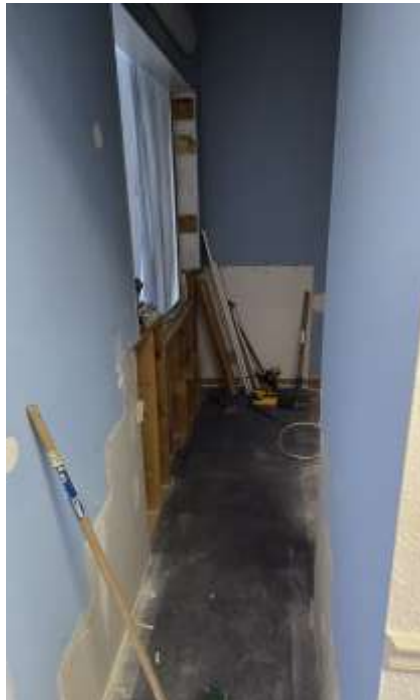
